








The Future IT a Warfighter Wants

Warfighter/User Expectations

- **Highly connected** - "I need access to information rapidly and with necessary fidelity."
- **Extremely mobile** - "I need the same access to information regardless of where I am."
- **Very secure & trustable** - "I need to know who I am talking to (IFF) and to be convinced that the information sent is received without being altered."
- **Reliable and dependable** - "The enterprise just needs to work."
- **Collaborative** - "I need to be able to reach out and touch anyone, including industry partners and allies, at anytime using e-mail, text, audio, video and planning tools."
- **Information consumer** - "I need access to meaningful information."
- **Information provider** - "I need to be able to provide meaningful information to others."
- **Time and space presence** - "If I choose, the network needs to know where I am so I can get focused information to meet my mission needs and so I can provide information to others based on my geolocation."
